2022 Score Recorder Report

16th October 2022

Mr. President, elected committee members & 3DAAA Members, I would like to take the opportunity to thank the committee for allowing & trusting me to participate in the role of Score Recorder this year.

Coming into the role, the job description was open for interpretation and the toolbox to do this role was not available. This meant a bit of trial and error in the beginning to create work sheets and the web page sheet very quickly, a small challenge but one I enjoyed. I would like to thank the committee members for their assistance during the year in my role and as well I would like to thank both previous score recorders (Tracey Warner & Grant Elsley) for their assistance when I needed advice.

The role began very quickly with the Victorian sanctioned events already to role and compete, followed closely by NSW shoots. The race didn't slow down then, coming up strongly behind the early sanctioned events was the National Indoor championships. Again, it was a scramble to create a scoring sheet as there was not one provided in the toolbox for me to use. I was lucky enough to assist Tracey Warner a few years ago with this, who provided me with an insight into what to check and an idea of the scoring sheet required.

2022 also included the introduction of "the eleven ring", which raised the issue of confirming "100's" claimed at sanctioned events, immediately. Initially I would have to have score cards sent through to confirm the range shot on and check the scoring for the 100 was correct. After a few shoots and many hours doing this, it was deemed necessary to have the scoring program modified so that a report could be produced at the end of the sanctioned event. Thank you to Nathan Butterfield who worked with the programmer to create a 100's verified report which is sent through with the end of shoot reports, and has made this part of the role much easier.

During 2022 there were 16 Sanctioned events held during the year held over the three states.
