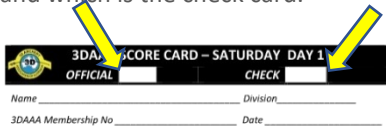

## 2023 SCORE CARD

After the first couple of trials of the 2023 score card, the committee have made a few small adjustments to the layout of the new score card.

The 2023 Score Card has:

- You still require 2 score cards completed and correctly filled out when handing your scores in. At the top of the new score card you will need mark which is the official card and which is the check card.



- One column for you to place your exact score in, reducing the risk of placing a score in the wrong column and adding it up incorrectly.
- There is an added column for the scores to initial when a correction has been made to a the score card.
- At the end of the score sheet there is an area for you to put your total of 11's, 10's, 8's, 5's and 0's scored. This is used to help you with a quick score check, and for the main purpose to provide the score recorders an easier quick and accurate way to do a count back, when required.

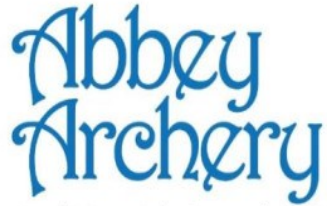

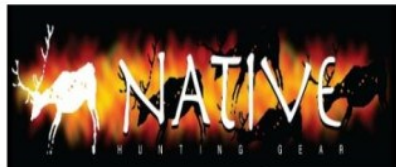
